Emphasizes border security

- Noted border security as an important issue at a campaign event, saying, "We have drugs coming into this country that are killing people like my brother, like my classmates from high school. Like everybody in our area, they know somebody that's died from fentanyl!"



Vocal on issues pertaining to inflation and cryptocurrency

- Stated his intent to counter Biden's "reckless spending" and reduce prices at a campaign stop; believes the US should lead in innovation in part by allowing cryptocurrency markets to operate without strenuous regulation and competition from central bank digital currencies (CBDCs)

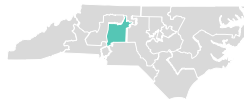
