POLICY POSITIONS



Calls for increased educational funding and teacher salaries

- On her campaign website, Alsobrooks calls for increased investments in education, specifically for improving school buildings and increasing pay for teachers; alsobrooks believes that education should not be funded by local governments, which rely on local property taxes to fund public education; advocates for an increase in Title I funding to lift the burden of education funding from local government budgets



Advocates for federal abortion access rights and universal background checks on firearm sales

- If elected, Alsobrooks vows to co-sponsor the Women's Health Protection Act to establish federal legal protections to abortion access; opposes any efforts to defund Planned Parenthood; proposes universal background checks and a ban on bump stocks and military-style weapons from public ownership as a means to curb gun violence in the United States; believes that gun companies should not have legal protections from being prosecuted for their marketing practices or responsibility in gun violence nationwide
