Takes an all-of-the-above approach to energy development

In an op-ed to the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, McCormick acknowledged that climate change is real and happening and proceeds to call for unleashed domestic production of oil and gas; believes in the US should take an all-of-the-above approach to energy development; states that nuclear power should be a significant part of US energy



Supports tougher policies along the US-Mexico border

Describes the environment at the US-Mexico border as a "humanitarian, national security, and economic crisis of epic proportions" and blames the Biden administration for the current state of affairs; supports the construction of the border wall and the restoration of the Trump-era Remain in Mexico policy



Blames the Biden administration for rising inflation rates and opposes China's economic influence

Holds President Biden responsible for increased inflation over the last few years; calls for policies that cut back on federal spending levels; supports policies that would benefit the blockchain and crypto industry
