Staunch believer in grant programs and government aid to small businesses

Promised to increase infrastructure investments in roads, bridges, and mass transit; committed to reducing trade tensions with China; funded more than \$250 million in grants for women-and minority-owned businesses; focused on improving employment opportunities for formerly incarcerated and disabled persons



Focused on affordable housing and public transportation

Instituted free bus rides for Westchester residents during the summer and holiday seasons; built over 2,500 affordable housing units during his time as Westchester County Executive



Champions abortion rights, firearms restrictions, and social security

Signed legislation expanding access to reproductive health clinics in Westchester County; supports ban on assault we apons and universal background checks; in favor of restricting with mental health issues from accessing firearms
