Ardent supporter of military committed to preserving its resources

- Supports the Space Force combatant command's location in Colorado Springs but does not oppose the planned relocation to Alabama under the Trump administration's view of Colorado abortion laws; said closing military bases is a "tragedy for the taxpayers" in a June debate



Fiscal conservative supports cutting DOE funding

- Believes high government spending resulted in high interest rates; supports disbanding a number of federal agencies including the Department of Education



Strongly supports closed border

- Backs a complete shutdown of the US-Mexico border; supports a large-scale deportation program

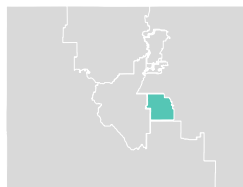
