POLICY POSITIONS



Takes an all-of-the-above approach to ensuring US energy independence

- Founded the Conservative Climate Caucus, which aims to reduce emissions without avoiding fossil fuels; claims that he has done more to support US oil and gas than any other member of Congress



Has introduced policies that aimed to ensure innovation on the internet and consumer safety in technology

- Introduced HR 1345, the NTIA Policy and Cybersecurity Coordination Act, which sought to establish an Office of Policy Development and Cybersecurity within the National Telecommunications and Information Administration to promote internet competition, security, and commercialization; authored HR 4081, the Informing Consumers about Smart Devices Act, that would require companies to disclose when their products have cameras or microphones
