Supports voting rights, campaign finance reform, and government accountability; plans to promote fair maps, judicial reforms, and measures to strengthen public trust in democratic institutions



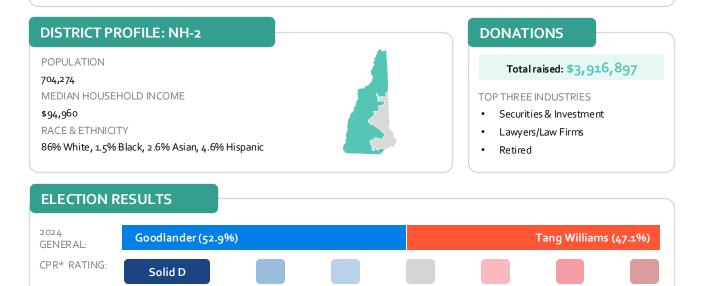
Hopes to make every day living more affordable
